## Why should my business recycle?

Recycling and reuse of materials contributes to the conservation of our limited natural resources and helps reduce greenhouse gases. These days, customers, employees and vendors expect companies to be environmentally conscious and state and regional governmental agencies have established waste diversion and recycling standards that impact Pleasanton. To meet these expectations Pleasanton Garbage Service is now offering a new voluntary Single Stream commercial recycling program that allows local businesses to recycle as part of our regularly scheduled refuse collection services.

### ONE RECYCLING CART DOES IT ALL

The new Single Stream commercial recycling program provides your business with an opportunity to recycle paper, cardboard, cans, bottles, glass bottles and jars in one 96-Gallon Single Stream Recycling Cart which will be available to all Pleasanton Garbage Service customers beginning in March, 2011. The cart will be picked up weekly at the curb, or adjacent to your existing trash enclosure. If additional carts or larger recycling bins are required, please call Pleasanton Garbage Service at (925) 846-2042 to discuss your service options.

### WE DO THE SORTING FOR YOU

Single Stream recycling is fast and easy! Just place all your dry paper, cardboard, aluminum cans, steel or tin cans, plastic bottles, glass bottles and jars in the 96-Gallon Single Stream Recycling Cart. Remember, placing inappropriate material, such as lawn clippings or food waste in the Single Stream Cart will contaminate material otherwise suitable for recycling.

## FAQs

### What if I'm not sure that a 96-gallon recycling cart will meet our needs?

### I have a lot of cardboard. What should I do with it?

Businesses that generate more cardboard than can fit in a 96-Gallon Single Stream Recycling Cart can call Pleasanton Garbage Service to order a cardboard-only container.

### Do you have a commercial organics program?

Our commercial food scrap program will become available to commercial accounts later this year.

Delivery and collection of the 96-gallon Single Stream Recycling Cart is part of the overall refuse and recycling fee approved by the City of Pleasanton in 2009.
